Club Championships:

The Club Championships held on the 25 February were once again a great success. Thanks to all the volunteers who helped out, particularly Brooke Lander and Wagin Anstey-Sprigg (stroke referees and check starting), Bruce Gook (starter), Debbie Garrigan (chief time-keeper), Roger Jukes and Adam Sims (BBQ), and all those who helped out in time-keeping.

Club receives support from Telstra Assistance Fund:

The Club successfully applied for equipment assistance from the 2006 Telstra Assistance Fund, and has received an equipment cage, 10 kickboards, and 10 pull-buoys. These items are stored at the Kyneton swimming pool, and the Macedon Ranges Council's pool managers use the cage for storage of their equipment also. Telstra advise that we are among just over 100 clubs out of 564 across the nation to receive such support.

Club gains success in funding from State Government:

The Club also successfully applied for funding under the Country Action Grants Scheme through the Department of Victorian Communities. The \$3,475 is to go towards conducting a bronze medallion course for senior members of the Club. This will then enable the Club to provide one of the two appropriately qualified people required to oversee our training sessions, thus reducing potential cost flow on to the club and our membership (at least one life-guard qualified person is required for overall supervision).
